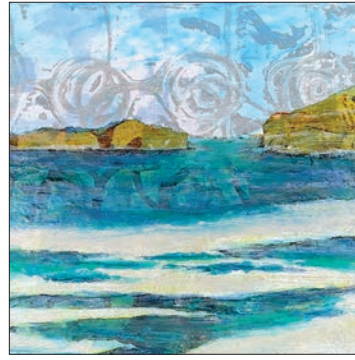

Valley Art Welcomes Art Enthusiasts, Supporters



We are delighted to welcome everyone to the gallery during our celebrated Annual Artist Event, Nov. 10-19. This year's theme is "We the Artists" – and "we" always have something to show and, frequently, something to say.

Forest Grove and Washington County have many dedicated Valley Art enthusiasts. For 57 years — our gallery was founded in 1966 — we have sought the best art to display and sell. Beginning with a dozen organizers who were eager to promote the arts in Washington County, they encouraged others to become involved. They, in turn, encouraged "the makers" to get busy and create pottery, paintings, prints, and more. The desire to produce beautiful work truly



does bring out the best in us and leaves a rich legacy for future generations.

Our 10-day event begins with a reception on Nov. 10, from 7-9 p.m. It is for members only and their guests, so put the tickets we mailed you in a safe

place. We will serve hors d'oeuvres and dessert prepared by lovely Maggie Pike and there will be a variety of wines to sample.

During the 10 days of AAE, we offer new, renewing, and current members a one-time 10% discount during the event.

Members are encouraged to bring a guest with them, although they won't receive the 10 percent discount unless they become a member for \$25 that night. Look for your brochure and tickets in the mail.



There will be a raffle during our members' night reception, with a variety of great prizes. Raffle Tickets will be available for \$2 each. Buy several!

During this year's event we have added a couple of new artists: Debbie Teeter and Luis A. Jimenez.

Debbie says, "My love for making art goes back to my childhood. I didn't take it seriously until my last two years of high school." She went on to earn her BFA and MA in art education and currently teaches children and adults about art at the Village Gallery of Arts. Plants are often her subject matter. As Georgia O'Keeffe said, they are "cheaper than models and they don't move."

Luis, a Puerto Rican pyrographer, works with wood, resin, and mixed media. Pyrography is the use of



heated metal tools with which to “paint.” Puerto Rico is steeped in rich indigenous Taino, Spanish, and African-influenced traditions, and pyrography is part of that. With his love and passion for ancestral arts, Luis incorporates symbolic and cultural elements to connect spiritually with viewers. Meditation helps give him this connection, which he feels guides his creative process.

You will see the work of our many other artists in this newsletter, our AAE brochure, and in our Facebook and Instagram promotions. Please share these with your friends and relatives.

The Annual Artist Event hours will be Monday-Saturday, 11 a.m. – 5:30 p.m.; and on Sunday, 12 – 4 p.m.

Please join us. Come and “shop local” this holiday season and find one-of-a-kind gifts for friends or family.

Community Action's Family Shelter

Community Action's Family Shelter in Hillsboro exists as a critical lifeline for families who have become homeless and have nowhere else to turn. Their high priority clients are families with children.

Families who are unsheltered and are living in cars and hotels need a variety of services to get them back into housing and on their feet. The trauma and stress of becoming homeless -- for both adults and children -- cannot be understated. While the staff works with families to take the next steps toward new housing, everyone wants the temporary shelter to be a stable, safe, and nurturing environment. They want the shelter to feel like a home.

In July, the Family Shelter underwent some exciting changes, including security upgrades, the installation of new carpeting and the repainting of all the walls with colors that create a calming and comforting atmosphere.

The shelter received a donation of dressers and comfortable furniture, and a donation of paintings and photographs from local artists through Valley Art Gallery in Forest Grove. The artwork has been used to decorate the five resident bedrooms and the children's playroom.

The transformation of the Family Shelter acknowledges the importance of the physical environment in supporting trauma survivors' healing and recovery journeys. It fosters a sense of safety, control, and dignity, reinforcing our Community Action's Family Shelter commitment to providing a supportive and empowering space for those in need.

Community Action thanks the artists who generously donated work to Community Action's Family Shelter. It will be appreciated by many local families and children for years to come.

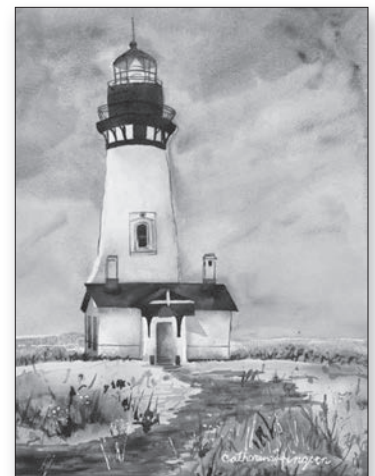
